General Meeting minutes 18 April 2024

The Committee accepted the minutes of the last General Meeting, these were formally moved by Linda Geddes and seconded by Karen Crowe.

President's and Treasurers report

The Acting President, Claire Pitham, briefly noted the success of the launch of the Tomakin Community Association's (TCA's) multi-sport structure (MSS). Claire noted that the MSS was the most ambitious project the TCA had undertaken, with an expenditure of over \$60,000. She also noted that the final Fires to Flourish (F2F) grant acquittal for \$7,500 had been finalised and sent to F2F (\$5,000 for capital and \$2,500 for the launch).

Claire also noted other projects that the TCA had been working on in the last 4 months, including liaising with the Eurobodalla Shire Council (ESC) on both the street lighting down to the Club, and the Sunpatch Parade Road works. The TCA also conducted a survey which asked TCA members what they wanted from the TCA, and on the 18th of April there were more than 50 responses.

The TCA's Treasurer, Peter Crowe, presented the TCA's financial report for the 2023-24 financial year. Claire noted the TCA was extremely grateful for both the grants received for the MSS build and launch (Commonwealth Government, the ESC and F2F), and sponsor generosity (TJ Concreting, AMH, MyAgent, Solahub, and Supernatural).

Kathy McKenzie noted that the mosaic project on the toilets was finished after 6 years. She thanked the TCA for supporting this project. She also recognized the other sponsors of the project, such as the IGA for extra funding support and the ESC in hanging the mosaics. Kathy said she understood that the ESC was going to pressure hose the mould off the toilet block in the near future.
